According to the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption 2018, Section 128, paragraph one, prohibits any government official from receiving property or any other benefits that may From whom is the income calculated? By ethics according to the criteria and numbers set by the NACC and the Police Code of Ethics. 2021, Section 2 (2) Honesty Performing duties according to law Regulations of the Royal Thai Police with transparency Do not show behavior that has implications for illegal exploitation. Responsible for human rights duties Be ready to receive audits and accept responsibility. Have good conscience Consider society and item 2(4), think about public benefits more than personal interests, have public spirit, cooperate, join together, and sacrifice in making benefits. For the public and creating benefits and happiness for society In addition, there is a plan to reform the country in terms of preventing and suppressing corruption and misconduct. (Revised Edition) Set important reform activities. Activity 4: Develop the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent and free from profit. Goal 1, Section 1.1. All government agencies must announce that all government officials will not accept gifts and gifts of any kind while performing their duties (No Gift Policy) in order to prevent conflicts between personal interests. and public interest (Conflict of Interest), accepting bribes, gifts, gifts, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties. and aims to be a good governance organization and is transparent In line with the values of the Royal Thai Police "honesty, transparency, and fairness"

Prajaksilpakom Police Station has established guidelines for anti-bribery practices. (Anti-Bribery Policy) and not accepting gifts, favors, or any other benefits (No Gift Policy) from performing duties. and to show the intention to resist corruption or accepting bribes in all forms as follows:

**Article 1:** This announcement

“**Commander**” means a person who has the authority to command, supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers under his command. In the Prajaksilpakhom Provincial Police Station commander It includes commanders in the hierarchy who are responsible for ordering, supervising, monitoring, and inspecting police officers in the chain of command.

“**Bribe**” means property or any other benefit given to a person to induce that person to act or not act in a certain position. Whether it is right or wrong according to duty

“**Performing duties**” means an act or performance of duties by a government official in an appointed position. or has been assigned to perform any duties or to act on behalf of the government in some capacity Both in general and specifically as a police officer as required by law. Powers and duties or acts in accordance with the powers and duties specified by law to be the powers and duties of the police.

“**Gifts, presents, or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties**” means money or property. Any other services or benefits that are valuable and include tips. received by government officials In addition to salary, income, benefits from government service in normal cases and affecting decisions, approvals, permissions, or anything else in the performance of duties in a manner that benefits in a dishonest way to the gift giver, both in the past or in the past while receiving or in the future

**Article 2:** Police officers at every level, every line of work at Prajaksilpakhom Provincial Police Station. Behave as follows:

1. Do not persuade, do not ask for directions, do not give or accept bribes, gifts, presents or any other benefits from the performance of duties.

2. Do not consent or connive with family members giving or receiving bribes, gifts, presents, or any other benefits to those involved in the performance of duties.

3. Practices must adhere to law enforcement with fairness, benefit and image. The appearance of the police is important. Must not do anything that is a conflict between personal interests. and public benefits such as receiving gifts or any other benefits that affect the performance of duties, the use of government resources Using stolen property for personal gain, disclosing information within the unit, hijacking government time to do extra work, etc.

4. Reduce giving or receiving property or any other benefits in accordance with ethics. according to the criteria and The amount specified by the NACC, using the method of expression by signing greeting cards, greeting books, cards. express condolences or using social media instead of giving things

5. Do not accept, do not tolerate, do not ignore the behavior of accepting bribes, gifts, gifts or any other benefits. from performing duties If any violations are found, please notify the Superintendent of Prajaksilpakom Police Station immediately.

**Article 3:** Commanding officers have the authority to supervise, monitor, and inspect police officers under their jurisdiction to conduct themselves in accordance with this announcement. In the event that an action that violates this announcement is found Please report to the Superintendent of Prajaksilpakom Police Station as soon as possible.

**Article 4:** Any person or police officer of Prajaksilpakom Provincial Police Station Found an action that violates With this announcement, you can make a complaint/report information directly through the Superintendent of Prajaksilpakom Police Station immediately. which the information of the complainant/informer will be concealed and kept strictly secret.

**Article 5:** In the case of receiving a complaint/clues Personnel or police officials under the jurisdiction of Prajaksilpakom Provincial Police Station commit such offense Prajaksilpakom Provincial Police Station will investigate the matter. And if an offense is found, the offender will be punished strictly in accordance with relevant laws, rules and regulations. and send matters according to the next command hierarchy.
